One of our three Major Goals this year is to: Fund and install an additional facility to expand our ministry capabilities – especially to children.

We have begun a six month drive to raise the \$100,000 needed for the project. Pledge cards and envelopes are at the Welcome Center for you to prayerfully consider what to give 'over and above' your regular giving to our general fund. Please place your pledge card in the offering baskets any Sunday. We ask that all monies be given within 6 months (end of July). You can give online, too. Go to our website: ccvero.org and click on the Giving tab – choose The Portable tab.

The plans, including doors, windows, room sizes, lighting, cabinets, etc. for the MAC have been finalized and submitted to Pac-Van who will construct the building. All flooring (carpet and vinyl), paint colors (outside and inside) and all other esthetics have been selected. Production time is scheduled to be 8-10 weeks until delivery!

To date \$77,725 has been generously given to fund the MAC. Thank you.

CCC's history includes many instances of God's Favor – both spiritual and financial. It has happened once again. After submitting our MAC plans to IRC, they initially slapped a 'Special Variance' on us that would have cost us an additional \$975. They also asked us to plant about 50 trees to act as a 'buffer' for Schacht's property (to the west). After a meeting and further review, we won't need the Special Variance. We will be required to plant 7 small canopy trees and several shrubs.
