Congregational Meeting

Last Sunday guests and a quorum of CCC members met for our annual business meeting that was an encouragement to all who attended.

Here are several highlights:

1. Matt Sprague was hired as CCC's Family Minister. (The first of our 3 goals!)
2. The Ministry Activity Center is here and paid for. (The second of our 3 goals!)
3. We have the IRC permit to complete our water project. (The third of our 3 goals.)
4. Middle/High School Back to School Bash with 60+ teens.
5. CCC welcomed 24 new members this fiscal year.
6. Our average attendance is 9.5% higher than last year and 20% higher these past 4 months over the same period last year.
7. Successful 6 week all-church program called Easter Experience.
8. Youth Group attendance doubled over the past 2-3 months.
9. The FY 2018 budget was met and the FY 2019 budget was approved unanimously.
10. 3 goals were set for FY 2019; Maximize the building with an average attendance of 200; 40 New Members; and 10 weekly Small Groups/Bible Studies.

Here's where we are at:

1. Pac-Van made a few minor needed adjustments, interior and exterior doors, cabinets, holes filled, etc.
2. Acoustic Doors & Specialties installed the ceiling track for the removal wall. It is being designed and built and will be here in 4-6 weeks.
3. Jim Peiffer is working with IRC to get our permit. Once we have that in hand, we can proceed with the electric, water, sewer, etc.
4. MBV has designed a deck/stairs/ramp that IRC will need to approve.
